CLASSES START AT 11:00 A.M. – Hot lunch and treats served all day!

- 1.) **Egg and spoon race for the kids - Champagne in champagne glasses for the adults** - may include riding at different gaits, change of direction, stop, back up, etc. until only one adult is left holding a fairly full glass of champagne and an egg in the spoon for the kids.
- 2.) **Bending Poles Race** - timed event around five poles where the horse/pony must weave in and out of the poles without knocking any of them over, turn around the last pole and return back to the start again weaving in and out of the poles. We may run heats side by side for even more thrills!
- 3.) **Ride A Buck** - \$1.00 bills for kids, \$5.00 bills for adults, winners keep all the money! This is a BAREBACK class and the bills will be placed for you! Whoever can keep their bills under their seat/leg the longest, wins all the money, and you will be asked to walk, trot, canter, change direction, until all but the winner's bills are dislodged.
- 4.) **Sack race** - ride as fast as you can from the start line to finish line, dismount and pick up a sack, and return to start line leading your mount and wearing the sack (on your feet)!
- 5.) **Knock down and out** - Jump a course until you knock a jump over, each jump counts for a point, the rider with the most points wins! The crowd can help keep count! Jumps approximately 2'6".
- 6.) **Obstacle course race** - a timed event, sort of like an English trail class, horse must navigate poles, go through an "L" and back up through that same "L", open a gate or mailbox, allow a rider to dismount and mount (with a block if necessary), take off a jacket, etc. Multiple riders on course at one time.
- 7.) **Ribbon pairs** - two riders ride together, this class is done as a group, and the two teammates hold a piece of crepe paper between them, and they will be asked to do anything the judge wants them to do! Last team with an unbroken ribbon wins.
- 8.) **Relay Race** - a timed event, can have up to four teammates, first rider walks, second rider trots, third rider canters, fourth rider TROTS.

Classes start at 11:00 a.m. and weather permitting, will be held in the hunt club arena, so use the clubhouse gate and park at the top around the clubhouse. If it is pouring, we will hold it indoors at Horseland Farm, which you can walk/ride to from the clubhouse.

More than one rider may ride the same horse in one class. If a rider wants to ride twice in one class on different horses, they may pay a class fee and get a different number in order to ride the second horse.
