| 1.) Woodbrook Family Class – Walk, trot and canter on each rein. | \$40/family |
| 2.) Second Flight Hunt & Handy Derby: a) Junior b) Senior c) Silver Fox | \$60 |
| This class combines a Classic Hunter course of 6-8 jumps immediately followed by a Handy course of 4-6 jumps for a total of 12 obstacles. The course will be set at 2'3" - 2'6". Competitors will be judged on performance, pace, jumping style, quality and substance, movement, and handiness. One point is added to the final score for each high option taken. | |
| 3.) First Flight Hunt & Handy Derby: a) Junior b) Senior c) Silver Fox | \$60 |
| This class combines a classic Hunter course of 6-8 jumps immediately followed by a Handy course of 4-6 jumps for a total of 12 obstacles. The course will be set at 2'9" - 3'0". Competitors will be judged on performance, pace, jumping style, quality and substance, movement, and handiness. One point is added to the final score for each high option taken. | |
| 4.) Junior Hunter Hack – Under saddle, will be asked to jump 2 fences no higher than 2'3". | \$30 |
| 5.) Senior Hunter Hack – Under saddle, will be asked to jump 2 fences no higher than 2'6". | \$30 |
| 6.) Silver Fox Hunter Hack – Under saddle, asked to jump 2 fences no higher than 2'6". | \$30 |
| 7.) Working Hunters Pairs Over Fences – Two horses or ponies per team (short course). | \$50/pair |
| 8.) Hunt Teams Over Fences - Three horses or ponies per team (short course). | \$75/team |
| 9.) The John P. Brooks, MFH, Memorial Field Hunter Performance Class – A timed speed derby with fences approximately 3'- 3'3" with high options to 3'6". Riders may be asked to cross a dry ditch, jump water, open/close a gate or other tasks encountered on a foxhunt. | \$60. |
